RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT

Categories
of persons
titled
to grant
of land.

In the context of the recent conflict with Pakistan, Government has reviewed the present policy of grant of Government land for cultivation to members of the armed forces or their families. Government considers that the outstanding contribution made by the members of the armed forces for the defence of the country should be recognised by the grant of land for cultivation and for residential purposes in rural areas to the families of the members of the armed forces and the Border Security Forces from Maharashtra State, who have either died or such personnel who have been wounded, disabled or have received awards for gallantry in the recent Indo-Pakistan conflict.

2. For the purposes of allotment of agricultural land, Government has decided to reserve the following areas of Government land in the various Districts of the State as shown below:-

- (a) An area measuring 10,000 hectares out of the Government Waste, Forest and Gairan lands released for cultivation on the recommendations of the District Survey Committees and indicated in column No.7 of the accompanying Statement "A".
- (b) An area measuring 1,099 hectares of land acquired from the benefitted zones of the Projects as indicated in column No.5 of the accompanying Statement "B", released by the Directorate of Rehabilitation.
- (c) An area equal to 2% in the benefitted zones to be acquired in other Projects, released by the Directorate of Rehabilitation.

3. The Collectors should immediately collect the details of all the categories mentioned above villagewise, and take action for the disposal of such lands to the members of the armed forces and the Border Security Forces, from Maharashtra State in accordance with the instructions given below:

4. Details of the personnel (Defence Personnel and personnel from Border Security Forces) eligible for the grant of such land are being obtained from the Headquarters of the Maharashtra and Gujarat Area. The details will include the names of the persons with their present address or posting as well as their home address. This list when received by the Revenue and Forests Department will be classified districtwise and immediately despatched to the Collectors. The Collectors in their turn should obtain formal applications from the persons or their dependents as the case may be and grant the land to the eligible persons in the categories mentioned in paragraph 1 above and upto the extent shown in paragraph 5 below. All the work relating to the receipt of the applications and the
