of collection and checking of collection of duty in the above mentioned villages or towns should be done in accordance with the arrangement sanctioned in Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. 2017/45, dated 20th February 1951 as amended by Government Endorsement No. 2017/45-L, dated 24th March 1951.

4. The actual receipts realised over a period of 12 months and maximum and minimum collection of duty should be reported to Government after the Act has been in operation for one year.

5. The expenditure is debitable to the head "13. Other Taxes".
