RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT

Government had had under consideration the question regarding the improvement of pay and prospects of Circle Inspectors and is pleased to direct that -

(i) promotion to the posts of Circle Officers of :

(a) the officers who have passed the Revenue Qualifying Examination or have been exempted from passing it, and

(b) the selected Circle Inspectors promoted as Circle Officers should be continued as at present in the ratio of 33:7 respectively;

(ii) only talathis should be appointed as Circle Inspectors and their first appointment should be made in the Second Grade of Circle Inspectors, but for the purposes of training the clerks in the field work, the Collector may temporarily appoint upto 25 per cent. Clerks as Circle Inspectors. These clerks should not be confirmed as Circle Inspectors;

(iii) the cadre of Circle Inspectors should be treated as separate cadre and not part of the clerical cadre;

(iv) a separate gradation list of Circle Inspectors should be maintained and published annually on 1st of July;

(v) the inter se seniority on the gradation list of Circle Inspector, in the case of those talathis, who are exempted from passing the Sub Service Departmental Examination of Clerks in accordance with Instruction No. 3 of the instructions accompany Government Resolution, No. 6763/33 dated 6th April 1949 as reprinted read with Government Letter No. 3347/45-19614-F, dated 1st April 1950, should be the seniority on the talathis grade while in the case of other talathis it should be according to the date of passing the Sub Service Departmental Examination for Clerks and if more than one person pass the examination, it should be based on the respective seniority on the talathis grade;

(vi) the promotion to the posts of Circle Officers meant for Circle Inspectors referred to in (i)(b) above should be made on the basis of the seniority on the gradation list of Circle Inspectors;

(vii) these orders take effect from 1st July 1952.

2. The Collectors should be requested to prepare the gradation list in the accompanying form * and in accordance with the above orders and forward it to Government within one month. If any anomaly arises, it should be referred to Government for clarification, but subject to orders of Government on these particular persons concerned, the gradation list should be prepared and not
