

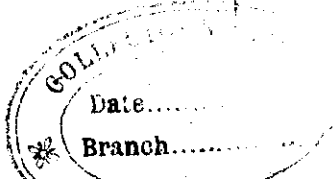

READ.

Government Resolution, Revenue Department NO.RVA.2557/
170960-R, dated 28th February 1958.

RESOLUTION: Government is pleased to direct that the following powers pertaining to establishment matters should ^{further} be delegated to the Commissioners of Divisions:-

- (i) Power to issue certificates under Rules 35 and 44(b) of the Bombay Civil Services Rules, Volume I in respect of the officers in the Mamlatdar's cadre whose names appear in the approved select lists of Aval Karkuns fit to be appointed as Mamlatdars.
- (ii) Power to issue notifications in respect of officers in the Mamlatdars' and Deputy Collectors' cadres, who hold additional charges of the posts in the Mamlatdars and/or Deputy Collectors grades, to enable them to draw special pay as admissible under the Appendix XLIV of the Bombay Civil Services Rules, Volume II;
- (iii) Power to transfer Assistant Collectors within the Division;
- (iv) Power to grant leave not exceeding 90 days to the Assistant Collectors and to make necessary arrangements in consequence of such grant of leave as well as other types of local arrangements such as arising out of death, accident and proceeding on training etc. of Assistant Collectors and issue orders of posting ~~of~~ after expiry of leave granted by them.
- (v) Power to notify, under the Commissioner's signature, in the Bombay Government Gazette, the transfers of Assistant Collectors effected by them, the nature of leave granted by them to the



ascertaining the same from the respective audit officer; holding of additional charges by Assistant Collectors of posts in the Deputy Collectors' grade and posting of Assistant Collectors returning from leave, granted by them.

2. The Commissioner-s should be requested to endorse to Government copies of the notifications issued by them in respect of transfers, grant of leave and reposting of Deputy Collectors and Assistant Collectors and additional ~~ex~~ charges held by the Deputy Collectors and Assistant Collectors under the powers delegated to them.
