Resolution: In partial modification of Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. TRG(RD) 1353, dated 6th January, 1954 Government is pleased to direct that the condition, "halts outside the headquarters should be of duration of not less than three nights at one and the same village and there should be not less than two such halts each month," should be relaxed during the monsoon season so that the Mamlatdar/Mahalkari can tour as many villages as possible.

The total number of halts prescribed for the year should not however be reduced.
