Read letter, No.BL.31-2/57, dated 19th November 1957
from the Director of Excise and Prohibition, Bombay.

RESOLUTION: According to the orders contained in Government Circular, Political and Services Department, No.CDR.1157, dated 15th October 1957 read with Government Notification, Legal Department, No.25393/B, dated 1st November 1956, the powers exercised by the authorities in the States of Madhya Pradesh, Hyderabad, Saurashtra and Kutch to pass final orders in departmental enquiries held against persons from the said areas, and impose penalties under the relevant Conduct Discipline and Appeal Rules, will devolve on the corresponding authorities in the reconstituted State of Bombay. A case has arisen wherein the powers exercised by the Member, Board of Hyderabad, under the Hyderabad Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1955 will therefore have to be exercised by the Government of Bombay, even in respect of non-gazetted Government servants. As, however, in the pre-reorganised State of Bombay the Heads of Departments under this department were the competent authorities to impose all prescribed penalties on non-gazetted Government servants under their respective control, Government is pleased to direct that, upto such time as the Conduct Discipline and Appeal Rules obtaining in the various constituent parts of the State are unified, the Heads of Departments under the administrative control of Revenue Department should exercise all powers and impose all the penalties under the respective Conduct Rules on the non-gazetted Government servants under their control in cases where the corresponding authority is the State Government.
