"Additional Collectors appointed under Government Resolution, No. EST-57/3957-F, dated 29th January, 1957 are authorised under the above Government Resolution to exercise the powers and discharge the duties as exercised and discharged by the Collector under section 2 (2E) of the Bombay Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act, 1948. The work under Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947 has close concern with the Tenancy Act and it has been assigned to the Additional Collector who has to exercise the powers and perform the duties of the Collector under the Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947.

2. It is, therefore, requested that the Additional Collector may be empowered to exercise the powers and discharge the duties as are exercised and discharged by the Collector under section 2 (11) of the Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947 read with section 8 of the Bombay Land Revenue Code, 1879."

RESOLUTION i- Government is pleased to direct that the Additional Collectors appointed under Government Resolution, No. EST.57/3957-F, dated 29th - January, 1957, should exercise the powers and discharge the duties as are exercised and discharged by the Collector of the respective districts under Section 2 (11) of the Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947 read with Section 8 of the Bombay Land Revenue Code, 1879.

2. A Notification to that effect should be published in the Bombay - Government Gazette, Part IV-B.
