Read Government Resolution No. LAQ.2558/V, dated 5th September 1958.

RESOLUTION.—In addition to the powers and functions conferred on the Commissioners concerned under certain sections of the Act mentioned in Government Resolution No. LAQ.-2558/V, dated 5th September 1958, Government is pleased to confer on the Commissioners concerned also the powers and functions under the following sections of the Act specified against each :—

2. The requisite notification* should be published in the *Bombay Government Gazette*.

3. The officers usually appointed as the Land Acquisition Officers are Assistant/Deputy Collectors, Sub-Divisional Officers, City Survey Officers, Mamlatdars/Tahsildars, Officers from the Town Planning and Valuation Department not below the rank of a Junior Assistant, and any other Officers specially appointed by Government in this behalf. The Commissioners concerned should therefore be requested to take care in the appointment of officers as a "Collector" under the respective Land Acquisition Acts and see that only the officers coming under the above categories are appointed for this purpose. In case the Mamlatdars/Tahsildars are proposed to be appointed, only sufficiently Senior and experienced officers should be appointed to do the full time work as the Special Land Acquisition Officers in the posts for such work sanctioned by Government.

4. The Settlement Commissioner and Director of Land Records should be requested to issue necessary correction slip to the Land Acquisition Manual.

BOMBAY COMMISSIONERS OF DIVISIONS ACT, 1957.

No. LAQ. 2558/V.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 3 of the Bombay Commissioners of Divisions Act, 1957 (Bom. VIII of 1958), the Government of Bombay hereby confers and imposes on the Commissioner concerned the powers and duties under the enactments hereinafter specified and for that purpose adds to and specifies in the Schedule to the said Act the following adaptations and modifications in those enactments by way of amendment, as follows, namely :—

In the Schedule appended to the said Act, the following entries shall be added at the end, namely :—

The Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894), in its application to the pre-Reorganisation State of Bombay excluding the transferred territories.

In section 3, in clause (c), after the words "appropriate Government" the words "or by the Commissioner" shall be inserted.

The Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894), as adapted and applied to the Saurashtra area of the State of Bombay.

The Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894), in its application to the Kutch area of the State of Bombay.
