RESOLUTION.:- Government is pleased to direct that in districts in which the Bombay Inferior Village Watan Abolition Act, 1958, has come into force, posts of Inferior Village servants, hereafter to be called Kotwals, should be created by the Collectors in accordance with the following scale with effect from the date on which the Act has come into force:-

<u>Population of village.</u>	<u>No. of Kotwals.</u>
Uninhabited village...	Nil
Upto 500	1
500 to 2,000	2
2,000 to and above.	3

2. These Kotwals should be given a consolidated remuneration inclusive of all allowances at the following rates:-

Rs. 18 per mensem per Kotwal in villages having a population of 500 or less.

Rs. 27 per mensem per Kotwal in villages having a population over 500.

3. Government is also pleased to direct that additional posts of Kotwals should be created in the following districts for the villages shown against their names.
