RESOLUTION:- After carefully considering the question of powers
vested in Collectors and Commissioners to grant leave to officers in the
Mamlatdar's grade, Government is pleased to direct that in modification of
the orders issued in paragraph 4 of Government Resolution No. APT.1257/D, dated
the 9th February 1957, the Collectors should be authorised to grant leave
to officers in the Mamlatdar's grade for a period not exceeding one month.
Any application from such officers for extension of leave beyond one
month or for grant of leave for more than one month should be referred to
the Commissioner concerned.

2. As regards the powers delegated to the Commissioners under
paragraph 1(i) of Government Resolution No. APT.1257/D, dated

the 9th February 1957, Government is pleased to authorise Commissioners to grant any amount of leave, except the special disability leave, admissible under the relevant Rules, to the officers in the Mamlatdar's grade under their control.
