RESOLUTION

Government is pleased to direct that until further orders Kotwals appointed in accordance with Rules sanctioned under Government Resolution Revenue Department No. PKA-1059-VI-L, dated 7th May, 1959, should with effect from 1st May 1960 be paid temporary increases at the following rates in their consolidated rates of remuneration sanctioned under Government Resolution Revenue Department No. PKA-1059-III-L, dated 25th February, 1959:

Present consolidated rate of pay inclusive of all allowances:	Increase sanctioned:	Increased consolidated rate of pay inclusive of all allowances:
Rs. 18/- p.m. per officiator.	Rs. 2/- per officiator.	Rs. 20 p.m. per officiator.
Rs. 27/- p.m. per officiator.	Rs. 3/- p.m. per officiator.	Rs. 30/- p.m. per officiator.

2. Collectors concerned should take steps to pay the accrued arrears to the Kotwals immediately.
3. The additional expenditure, which the present orders would entail during the current financial year should be met from the advance of Rs. 6,01,000 from the Contingency Fund sanctioned under Government Memorandum Finance Department No. CNF. II.60/270/XVII, dated 23rd November 1960 and debited to "25-General Administration-G-District Administrations-S-Other establishment-S1-Pay and Allowances to District and village Officers".

The Collectors should be requested to follow the procedure laid down in Rule 6 of the Contingency Fund Rules

and submit to Government every month the statement of expenditure incurred out of the advance from the Contingency Fund. They should also be requested to take the expenditure into account while preparing these raised estimates and re-appropriation accounts.
