Letter from the Settlement Commissioner and Director of Land Records, N. AC-181, dated 11th October 1961.

"Reference:- Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. Pen-1060/14200-E dated 8th September 1960.

Government have delegated to the Settlement Commissioner and Director of Land Records the power to sanction pension to the Officers in the cadre of the Superintendents of Land Records. There are, however, some posts designated as Assistant Superintendents, Land Records in Vidarbha, which have been equated with the posts of Head Quarter Assistants in Old Bombay State area. Although these posts are in the non-Gazetted cadre, the authority competent to sanction pension to the holders of these posts at present is Government, because Government is appointing authority under the Madhya Pradesh Land Revenue Code. The Superintendents of Land Records of the Circles are competent to sanction pension to the other non-gazetted officers working in their circle establishments. Government may, therefore, kindly be moved to delegate to the Superintendent, Land Records, Nagpur Circle, the power to sanction pension to the A.S.L.Rs. in Vidarbha which is certified by the audit officer to be clearly and strictly admissible under the Rules."

**RESOLUTION:-** With a view to furthering the decentralisation of Administrative powers, Government is pleased to delegate, under rule 6 of the Bombay Civil Services Rules to the Superintendent of Land Records, Nagpur Circle the power under Rule 213, to sanction to the holders of the posts of Assistant Superintendent of Land Records in Vidarbha Region the pension which is certified by the Audit Officer to be clearly and strictly admissible under the rules.

2. The necessary correction to Appendix I of the Bombay Civil Services Rules, Volume II will be issued by the Finance Department separately.
