READ:- Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No. EST. 5961/103770-F, dated 25th September 1961.

RESOLUTION:- In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 6-B. of the Bombay Land Revenue Code, 1879 (Bombay V. of 1879), the Government has appointed an Additional Commissioner, in the Poona Division. The said Additional Commissioner, shall exercise the powers and discharge the duties of the Commissioner of the said Division, under the provisions of the various Acts as specified in the accompanying Government Notification\*, Revenue Department, No. EST. 5961/107555-F, dated 4th October 1961 which should be published in the Maharashtra Government Gazette.

Bombay Land Revenue Code, 1879.

No. EST. 5961/107555-F.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 6-B of the Bombay Land Revenue Code, 1879 (Bom. V of 1879), the Government of Maharashtra hereby -

- (a) appoints in the Poona Division Shri S.M. Kamruddin, to be an Additional Commissioner, and
- (b) directs that the Additional Commissioner shall exercise the following powers and discharge the following duties of the Commissioner in the said division, that is to say -

1. Central Act and Rules - The Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (I of 1894) -

Section 3(c). The power of the Commissioner to appoint any officer as Collector.

Section 3A. The power of the Commissioner to authorise an officer to carry out preliminary survey.

Section 4. The power of the Commissioner to notify land needed for public purpose.

Section 5-A. The power of the Commissioner to decide validity of objections.

Section 6. The power of the Commissioner under Section 6.

Section 7. The power of the Commissioner to direct Collectors to take order for acquisition of land.

Section 17. The power of the Commissioner to apply urgency clause.

2. The Indian Arms Rules, 1951.

Rule 40(3) The power of the Commissioner to renew licences in forms XI proviso (a)(i) and XII when so directed by the Central Government.

Bombay Acts and Rules

3. The Bombay Ferries and Inland Vessels Act, 1868 (Bom. II of 1868) -

Section 2. The power of the Commissioner to constitute public ferries, establish new ferries and discontinue existing ferries.

Section 2-A. The power of the Commissioner to declare vesting of public ferries in local bodies, etc.

Section 5. The power of the Commissioner to lease public ferries, etc.

4. The Bombay Hereditary Offices Act, 1874 (Bom. III of 1874) -

Section 5. The power of the Commissioner to sanction alienation of watan for more than 30 years.

Section 77. The power of the Commissioner to entertain appeals against the decisions of a Collector.

Section 79. Powers of revision of the State Government delegated to the Commissioner.

Section 37-A. The power of the Commissioner to extinguish public rights over roads, etc.

6. The Bombay District Vaccination Act, 1892 (Bom. I of 1892) -

Section 5(2). The power of the Commissioner to accord concurrence to the appointment of places in each vaccination circle to be stations for performance of vaccination.

7. The Bombay District Municipal Act, 1901 (Bom. III of 1901) -

Section 10(2) The power of the Commissioner to fill in vacancy by nomination.

Section 15. The power of the Commissioner to decide appeals whether a vacancy has occurred in cases of municipalities (not being city municipalities).

Section 17. The power of the Commissioner to extend term of office of councillors.

Section 23(5). The power of the Commissioner to grant leave to the President and Vice-President.

Section 27A(2). The power of the Commissioner to nominate six persons on Pilgrim Committee during the super-session period of a municipality or of a Pilgrim Committee.

Section 27A(7). The power of the Commissioner to decide dispute between a Municipality and a Pilgrim Committee to pass budget of the Pilgrim Committee.

Section 35(5). The power of the Commissioner to authorise adoption by a municipality of procedure prescribed by section 35.

Section 46. The power of the Commissioner to approve rules made by district municipalities.

Section 46A. The power of the Commissioner to approve rules and alteration and rescission thereof.

Section 48. The power of the Commissioner to give previous sanction to by-laws framed by district municipalities and to alterations and rescission thereof.

Section 57. The power of the Commissioner to accord sanction to cancellation of arrangements purporting to be binding permanently or for a term of years by municipalities (other than city municipalities).

Section 60. The duty of the Commissioner to receive objections etc. under section 60.

Section 61. The power of the Commissioner to sanction or to

- Section 150. The powers and duties of the Commissioner under section 150.
- Section 165. The power of the Commissioner to give previous sanction to the compounding or compromising suit under section 165.

9. The Bombay Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1939 (Bom. XXII of 1939) -
- Section 3. The powers of the Commissioner under section 3 to regulate purchase and sale of agricultural produce in the specified area.
- Section 4. The power of the Commissioner to declare market areas.
- Section 4-A. The power of the Commissioner to declare market yards.
- Section 18. The power of the Commissioner to remove members of market committee.
- Section 19. The power of the Commissioner to supersede a market committee.
10. The Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947 (Bom. LXII of 1947) -
- Section 31(b) The power of the Commissioner to sub-divide holding.
- Section 35. Revisional powers of the Commissioner.
11. The Bombay Village Panchayats Act, 1958 (Bom. III of 1959) -
- Section 39(3). The power of the Commissioner to decide appeals against orders of removal of members, Sarpanchas or Upa-Sarpanchas from office.
- Section 128(2). The power of the Commissioner to decide appeals against an order under sub-section (1) of section 128 and to stay execution of such order.
- Section 130(c). The power of the Commissioner to accord sanction to write off irrecoverable sums exceeding Rs.500/-.
- Section 141. The power of the Commissioner to decide appeals

- Section 142(3). The power of the Commissioner to revise or modify the Collector's order regarding suspension of execution of order of Panchayats.
