"With reference to Government letter No. APT/1263-1395-D, dated 9th July 1963, on the subject cited above, I am to state that since Commissioners are not competent to issue notifications of promotion to the cadre of Mamlatdars of Aval Karkuns etc, not borne on the select list, this office obviously cannot take any action to issue pay slips to the concerned officers when they assume charge unless notification of their promotion is received from Government. Since the fact whether or not a particular promotion is made by the Commissioner with reference to select list is not indicated in the orders of promotion issued to this office it will be difficult for this office to know in which cases this office has to await the orders of Government. Consequently acceptance of all the orders of promotion issued by the Commissioners may lead to taking action on sanctions to appointment which are beyond the competence of the Commissioner, even though subsequently these promotions are notified by Government.

Government may therefore, kindly consider the suitability of issuing suitable instructions to the Commissioners to specify in their orders whether or not promotions are based on the select list so that in cases where Government sanction is to be awaited, this office can watch for the same before issuing Notifications to the concerned officers.

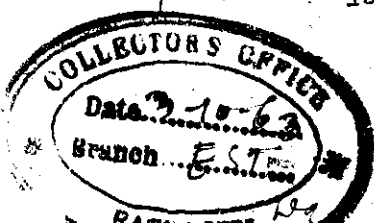
Very early action in the matter is requested."

RESOLUTION:- Government is pleased to resolve that the powers of the Divisional Commissioners to appoint Mamlatdars/Tahsildars (from select list of Aval Karkuns/Naib Tahsildars fit to be appointed as Mamlatdars/Tahsildars prepared by Government) and to issue notifications regarding such appointments under their signatures, delegated to them under Government Resolution, No. RVA 2557/170960-R, dated the 28th February 1958 should be withdrawn from the Divisional Commissioners and the same should be retained with Government. Government is accordingly pleased to direct that the entries under Columns 3 and 4 at Serial Number 16(h) in the Statement I appended to Government Resolution Revenue Department, No. RVA 2557/170960-R, dated the 28th February 1958 should be delegated.
