R E S O L U T I O N

The draft notification seeking the amendments of the rules published in the Maharashtra Education (Cess) Tax on lands and buildings (Collection and Refund) Rules, 1962 was previously published under Government Notification No. EDC.1062/124065-C, dated 28th April 1964 and suggestions and objections were invited in regard to the amendments. No suggestions or objections in respect of the said draft notification have been received by Government. The Notification should, therefore, now be published finally in part IV-B of the Maharashtra Government Gazette Extraordinary, dated 3rd July 1964.

2. The Director of Languages should make immediate arrangements to translate the Government Notification into Marathi and Hindi in Devnagari Script and send the translation to the Manager, Government Central Press, Bombay for publication in the Maharashtra Government Gazette by 13th July 1964.

3. The Manager, Government Central Press is requested to print sufficient number of copies of the Notification in English, Marathi and Hindi and to supply them to the Officers immediately according to the distribution list *appended to this Government Resolution.

Maharashtra Education(Cess)Act, 1962.

No.EDC 1062/124065-C: In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses(b)and(f) of sub-section (2) of section 26 of the Maharashtra Education(Cess)Act, 1962 (Mah.XXVII of 1962) The Government of Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules to amend the Maharashtra Education(Cess)tax on lands and buildings (Collection and Refund) Rules, 1962 the same having been published as required by sub-section (3)of the said, section 26, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Education(Cess)Tax on Lands and Buildings (Collection and Refund) (Amendment) Rules, 1964.

2. In the Maharashtra Education (Cess)Tax on Lands and Buildings (Collection and Refund) Rules, 1962, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal rules"), to rule 4, the following shall be added at the end, namely:-

"provided that where a Government Treasury is situated at a distance of more than eight Kilometres from the office of a municipality, and the Bank in which the Municipality has account is situated at a lesser distance from such office the sums so collected during any month shall be credited to the Government Treasury before the 7th day of the month immediately following; and until the sums are credited to the Government Treasury, they shall be credited to the account in the bank with which the Municipality has an account:-

Provided further that where the sum so collected exceeds during any week two hundred rupees, it shall be credited to the Government Treasury before the expiry of the week immediately following.

3. In rule 8 of the principal rules, for the words "a monthly return" the words "a monthly return showing the progress of collection of tax on lands and buildings" shall be substituted.
