RESOLUTION :

Government recently modified the scheme for the
appointment of Kotwals in villages. Consequently a large number
of Kotwals have been retrenched in various districts. For
helping the retrenched Kotwals in the matter of employment,
Government is pleased to direct as follows:-

- 1) While making fresh appointments to posts of
peons, attendants, watchmen etc. in all State Government
Offices, preference should be given to the retrenched Kotwals,
who are fit and willing and excluding those retrenched on
account of their age or land holdings.
- 2) Lists of such retrenched kotwals considered
suitable for employment as peons, attendants, watchmen, etc.
should be furnished by all the Mamletdars/Tahsildars/Mahalkaris
in respect of the areas in their charge / to the concerned Employment Exchanges;
on receipt of these
lists, the officers in charge of the concerned Employment
Exchanges should register all the persons contained in the
lists and recommend their names for employment in Government
offices as and when such requisitions are received by them.
- 3) These orders should remain in operation till
the 31st March 1966.
- 4) The prescribed age limit for appointment in
a Government office should be relaxed in favour of retrenched
kotwals to the extent of the number of years for which he

had worked continuously prior to retrenchment.
